PRESS RELEASE

Chief Judge Anthony J. Scirica of the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit announces the appointment of a Merit Selection Committee to recommend candidates for a bankruptcy judgeship in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania. Once selected, the judge will sit in Philadelphia. Established pursuant to regulations of the Judicial Conference of the United States, the role of the Committee is to review applications, conduct interviews, and recommend individuals whose character, experience, ability and commitment to equal justice under the law fully qualify them to serve as United States bankruptcy judges.

The members of the Committee are practitioners in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania with diverse backgrounds and expertise. Joseph A. Dworetzky, shareholder at Hanglely Aronchick Segal & Pudlin, has been appointed to chair the Committee. Joining Mr. Dworetzky on the Committee: Professor Amelia H.
