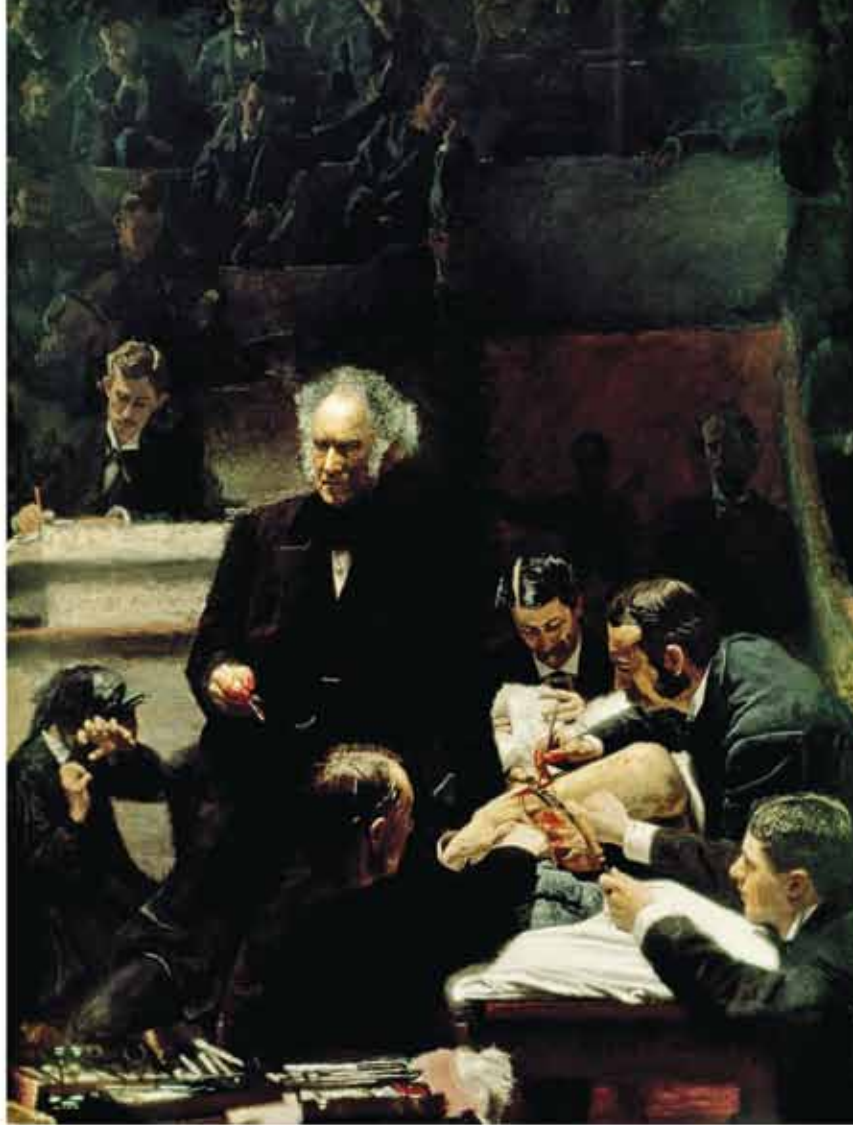
Bar-News Media Conference Committee 1973
